

PEACE GARDEN GUIDELINES
ST. PETER'S SCHOOL



The PEACE GARDEN is a symbol of the school's commitment to peace.
Follow these GUIDELINES to make the garden thrive.

MAY : Rake beds & pathways
Trim winterkill from trees, shrubs & cedar bushes
Whipper-snip around trees, shrubs & the edges of the beds
Secure funding (e.g. plant sale, CPTA or other donations, grants)
Plan projects for the current year
Remind students to be careful of new growth

JUNE : Fertilize & plant vegetable bed
Fertilize, divide, tidy up perennials
Plant new trees, shrubs or replace old ones
Plant flowers
Mulch trees & under stones around the big rock
Mulch & weed around gazebo
Set up hoses (after school is out)

JULY & AUGUST : Keep garden well-watered & weeded

END OF AUGUST : Weed & tidy up beds & especially around gazebo
Whipper-snip pathways, around shrubs
Edge garden beds
Paint black bench
Paint Peace Garden sign (every 3 or 4 years)

SEPTEMBER : Bring in hoses
Plant daffodils, mums
Harvest vegetables

OCTOBER : Cut back perennials
Rake & tidy-up beds

NOVEMBER : Receipts & financial summary to Principal & CPTA
